Steering Committee Member

Membership of our steering committee is to be drawn from a variety of stakeholders including business, labour, **research, people with lived experience of low paid precarious employment, municipal government**, service providers and advocacy organizations. *Those bolded above are the areas we are in particular need for representation from at this time.*

As a Steering Committee member you would be responsible for supporting LWWR staff in meeting project goals, encouraging employers to become recognized Living Wage Employers and sharing the benefits of a Living Wage.

Time Commitment: 2-5 hrs/month

Working Group Member

As a volunteer you would not be required to attend the monthly steering committee meeting but would work closely with the staff and individual working groups to assist with the LWWR initiatives.

The current working groups include;

- **Employer engagement** (events, meeting with interested employers)
- **Communications** (newsletters, videos, social media, messaging)
- **Municipal Engagement**
- **Evaluation** (surveying, interviewing, reporting)
- **Research**
- **Calculation** (annual calculation of living wage)

Time Commitment: 2-3 hrs/month
